Dear Friends and Supporters,



Dating back to the beginning of the 18th century, Sweden came into close contact with current Moldavia. It was after Karl XII's defeat at Poltava, when the Swedish king with around 1500 soldiers retreated to Varnitsa outside Bender in the part of the Ottoman Empire which today is Moldavia. During the years 1709-1713 practically all of

Sweden was ruled from there. The occupation ended with the so called Tumult in Bender. Three hundred years later, in 2006 to be exact, the SB Foundation arrived at Moldavia under more peaceful circumstances when Elisabeth and Lena visited the southern part of the country. Today's Moldavia is a republic in Eastern Europe, bordering Romania and the Ukraine. Its 3.5 million inhabitants are some of the poorest in Europe. The country has been governed by Mongolians, Ottomans, Russians, Romanians. During the Stalin regime many of the country's inhabitants were deported to Siberia and replaced by Russians. In 1991 Moldavia declared itself independent from the Sovjet Union. National politics are characterized by deep antagonisms between parties oriented towards Russia and those towards the European Union. Recently there was an election that turned out to favor the latter.

Ever since the Foundation's first contact we have sent Christmas gifts to children in Moldavia every year. The picture above shows children receiving stuffed animals last year, donated by Handelsbanken's Foster Child Fund, which our Foundation was happy to pass on. The nice message below came to the Foundation the other day, when this year's boxes of Christmas gifts had arrived.
