Anu Raagmaa, who works at the Aiboland Museum in Estonia, writes in an email to SB Foundation about the 16th century Holy Martin church in the county of Hapsal and its small congregation of around one hundred members. The priest, Küllike Valk, who is also the dean of the region with responsibility for several churches, is very active and a driving force in the congregation. Anu, who belongs to the congregation, tells us that the members of the congregation do what they can to help, for example, together with the children they bake large, beautiful gingerbread cookies to give to everyone who comes to church on Christmas Eve, as well as to the elderly who are not able to make it to church. At Easter, they paint eggs that are similarly distributed. And now, in October, they organize a lottery at the market.
