




Students who have completed required

classes for first through eighth grade (Primary School) take a "board exam" compiled by a state education board. Similarly, after completion of grades 9 and 10 (Middle School), they take a state board exam for those years. These exams are taken at a different school than the one the students normally attend. It takes three months after the students take the exams to receive the results. If they pass, they are promoted to Middle School (grades 9–10) and High School (grades 11–12), respectively. Currently, they are waiting for their results, full of hope and anticipation.

The annual Sports Day is always eagerly awaited by the students at the School for the Blind. The event began with a parade. Here, a tug-of-war competition is taking place.
