ROMANIA - Voivodeni Conveyor Belt for Harvesting and Lice Control

Dear Friends and Supporters,



A request came from Voivodeni for a conveyor belt to assist in the harvesting of corn and other crops. The pictures show what such a belt looks like. SB Foundation was able to help with the financing. We are happy to be able to ease the heavy labor in the fields in this way. As the Bible reminds us, we should "carry each other's burdens".











A completely different problem that has now affected Voivodeni is the rapid spread of both head lice and bedbugs once they gain a foothold. If even one student becomes infested, soon all classmates can be affected. Bedbugs are even harder to get rid of. They hide in cracks, crevices, and mattresses during the day but come out at night to attack unsuspecting sleep-

ing individuals. To enable the purchase of insecticides, SB Foundation had to step in once again. The woman on the right is showing the package of anti-lice treatment she received for her family. In the first attempt, the mother of four on the left was unable to eliminate the lice in her home and requires additional help. Particularly in the simple homes where many Roma families live, it is difficult to eradicate the lice from all the hiding places they retreat to. Pastor Denes Csaba writes that repeated lice treatments need to be urgently carried out in

thirteen homes; otherwise, there is a high risk of reinfestation.
