10. What would you do if you were a policeman, a doctor or a lawyer?

A New school year has started and we have received our first report from the school project in Floresti, Romania. Translated into Swedish, here is the message:

Dear Friends,

With the help of God we are now starting a new school year 2019-2020. The project is named "I'm a student and it is awesome!" The project is in its sixth year. Is this possible? Seeing the changes these past years is encouraging. We participate in the progress in these children's lives! Of course with the help of God and the SB Foundation!

Pre-school 7
First grade 7
Second grade 7
Third grade 6
Fourth grade 5*

Last year we told you about the number of classes having increased from 17 to 25, since the project started in 2014. Amazing - we now have 32 classes! When we started the project six years ago, the school had 479 students, 182 of whom were Gypsies. Today there are 1056 students, 403 of whom are Gypsies. (Note: In Romania they are not called Romani.) Now we work at expanding the school, hoping that the new building will be ready for use by October. Thanks for the humanitarian help sent by the SB Foundation last summer. We managed to deliver bags of clothes to all these 403 Gypsy students and their families.

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
